Regulations

1. Goals and objectives

- 1.1. To determine the Tournament winner.
- 1.2. To develop and raise popularity of youth football in Latvia.
- 1.3. To improve sport skills of football players, referees and coaching staff.

2. Tournament management

- 2.1. The Riga City Cup 2020 Tournament will be organized and managed by organization “Rīgas futbola skolas atbalsta biedrība” in cooperation with Riga Football School and SIA “Riga Bumbo”.

3. Venue and time

- 3.1. All games are organized on artificial turf.
- 3.2. SK Arkādija stadium, Rīga, Uzvarās bulvāris 18.
- 3.3. 89.vsk. stadium, Rīga, Hipokrāta iela 27.
- 3.4. Juglas vsk. stadium, Rīga, Kvēles iela 64.
- 3.5. Rīgas Pļavnieku pamatskola stadium, Rīga, Jāņa Grestes iela 14.
- 3.6. 96.vsk. stadium, Rīga, Auru iela 6A.
- 3.7. Centra sporta kvr. stadium, Rīga, Krišjāņa Barona iela 116A.
- 3.8. Rīgas klasiskā ģimnāzija stadium, Rīga, Purvciema iela 38.

 - 4.1.1. U-15 – born after 01.01.2006.
 - 4.1.2. U-14 – born after 01.01.2007.
 - 4.1.3. U-13 – born after 01.01.2008.
 - 4.1.4. U-12 – born after 01.01.2009.
 - 4.1.5. U-11 – born after 01.01.2010.
- 4.2. Number of players in Match (11x11) sheet – 18, number of substitutions – 7.
Number of people in team – max. 25.
- 4.3. Number of players in Match (8x8) sheet – 16, number of substitutions – unlimited. Number of people in team – max. 20.

5. Competition system

- 5.1. Boys (11x11):



- 5.1.1. Number of teams: 10.
 - 5.1.2. 2 groups of 5 teams. 4 games for every team in group stage. After the group stage 5th placed team of each group plays for 9th place in tournament. Top 4 teams of each group play semi-finals and finals for 1st-4th and 5th-8th places. 5 games in minimum are guaranteed for every team.
 - 5.1.3. If two or more teams are equal on points on completion of the tournament, the following criteria are applied, in the order given, to determine the rankings:
 - 5.1.3.1. higher number of points obtained in the tournament matches played among the teams in question;
 - 5.1.3.2. superior goal difference resulting from the tournament matches played among the teams in question;
 - 5.1.3.3. higher number of goals scored in the tournament matches played among the teams in question;
 - 5.1.3.4. superior goal difference in all tournament matches;
 - 5.1.3.5. higher number of goals scored in all tournament matches;
 - 5.1.3.6. lower disciplinary points total based only on yellow and red cards;
 - 5.1.3.7. penalty's - three penalty shots to each team. Should tie persist, one penalty shot each team until there is a winner. Team have to use a different player for each shot until all players have been used.
 - 5.1.4. If there is a tie game at the end of regulation time during the tournaments play-offs, the following rules will apply: penalty's - three penalty shots to each team. Should tie persist, one penalty shot each team until there is a winner. Teams have to use a different player for each shot until all players have been used.
- 5.2. Boys (8x8):**
- 5.2.1. Number of teams: 15.
 - 5.2.2. 3 groups of 5 teams. 4 games for every team in group stage. After the group stage the teams divided into three new groups (gold, silver and bronze). Gold group - three teams that won the first place in their qualification group and two best teams that stand's the second place in their qualification group. Silver group - one team that stand's the second place in its qualification group, three teams that stand's the third place in their qualification group and one better team that stand's the fourth place in its qualification group. Bronze group - two teams that stand's the fourth place in their qualification group and three teams that stand's the fifth place in their qualification group. 8 games are guaranteed for every team.
 - 5.2.3. If two or more teams are equal on points on completion of the tournament, the following criteria are applied, in the order given, to determine the rankings:
 - 5.2.3.1. higher number of points obtained in the tournament matches played among the teams in question;
 - 5.2.3.2. superior goal difference resulting from the tournament matches played among the teams in question;
 - 5.2.3.3. higher number of goals scored in the tournament matches played among the teams in question;



- 5.2.3.4. superior goal difference in all tournament matches;
- 5.2.3.5. higher number of goals scored in all tournament matches;
- 5.2.3.6. penalty's - three penalty shots to each team. Should tie persist, one penalty shot each team until there is a winner. Team have to use a different player for each shot until all players have been used.

5.2.4. If there is a tie game at the end of regulation time during the tournaments play-offs, the following rules will apply: penalty's - three penalty shots to each team. Should tie persist, one penalty shot each team until there is a winner. Teams have to use a different player for each shot until all players have been used.

6. Law of the Game

- 6.1.** Matches are played according to FIFA and LFF (Latvian Football Federation) regulations.
- 6.2.** Match time:
 - 6.2.1. Boys (11x11): 1x30min
 - 6.2.2. Boys (11x11): 2x15min
- 6.3.** Players in field: 11*11
- 6.4.** Players in field: 8*8
- 6.5.** Substitutions: Unlimited
- 6.6.** A sent off player is suspended for the next match.

7. Medical assistance

- 7.1.** Organizers of the Tournament are not responsible for the damages that the participants cause to themselves or to other participants during the competition. There will be a First Aid station at the venues of the Riga City Cup 2021 where participants may receive ice, etc. for minor injuries.

8. Awards

- 8.1.** A winner, runner up and the 3rd place winner of the Tournament will be awarded with cups and medals.
- 8.2.** Trophies for the best players of tournament.

9. Financial provisions

- 9.1.** Each team bares international travel costs of their team. Each team bears the cost of a local transportation and accommodation.
- 9.2.** Tournament fee:
 - 9.2.1. Boys (11x11): 250 EUR per team.
 - 9.2.1.1. Teams from Riga get a 25% discount.
 - 9.2.2. Boys (8x8): 150 EUR per team.
 - 9.2.2.1. Teams from Riga get a 25% discount.
